

**Rencontre : La place des femmes en linguistique : l'inclusivité et les étapes à venir |  
Meeting: Women in linguistics: Inclusiveness and next steps**

There is a growing tendency to ask whether there remains a problem of gender discrimination in linguistics. This is not a trivial matter to assess given the undeniable advances in gender equality. The goal of this forum is to launch the conversation in the context of Canadian Linguistics, and to determine whether there is an interest on the part of the CLA membership to resurrect the CLA Committee on the Status of Women. We propose to hold a conversation that explores the following issues:

1. Is there still a glass ceiling for women in Canadian linguistics, and if so, how do we break through?
2. Is there unconscious bias in treatment of students, job applicants, & if so, how do we address the problem of unconscious bias?
3. Is there a need to resurrect the CLA Committee on the Status of Women?

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
