Financial report: Our total funding was \$1,487.85 from the University of Victoria Graduate Student Society, the Canadian Linguistics Association, the Departments of Linguistics and Indigenous Education, and the student union of linguistics undergraduate students at UVic, Underlings. Our total expenses were \$1,455.37: \$824.96 for breakfasts, lunches, snacks, and beverages; \$48.02 for breakfast and lunch supplies such as plates, napkins, and cutlery; \$57.39 for stationary such as folders, name tags, and badges; \$400 for honoraria for our two keynote speakers; and \$125 in thank-you gift cards for our volunteers. Our excess of \$32.48 will be e-transferred to the Underlings, as they donated free buttons and stickers to the in-person attendees.
